Could this be one shape of lighting to come? Italian company Muvis's stylish collection of interactive floor, wall and table lamps enables genuine interaction between the user and the lit environment. The small, curvy lamps hold three 50W halogen dichroic spots, either all in white or in red, white and blue. (LED versions are also planned.) The spots can rotate 180 degrees over two axes.

This allows the user to control the size, direction, intensity and colour of the beams from the comfort of the sofa. Want to brighten the lights in the kitchen? Shift a beam so it isn't shining on the television screen? Create a blue mood? Direct more light on to your book? Simply hit the remote. Up to 20 themes can be programmed, and no special installation is required.
